## Class ages for all entries:-

Senior Classes - 1st July 2022 to 31st December 2022

Junior Classes - 1st January 2023 onwards

Highland Classes - 1st January 2022 onwards

## Classes will be split after all entries are received.

If there are less than 15 entries in any breed, they will automatically go into the 'Any Other Breed' section. The Committee has the right to refuse any entries.

**Prize money –**  $1^{st}$  = £40,  $2^{nd}$  = £30,  $3^{rd}$  = £20,  $4^{th}$  = £10

There will be a **£50 cash bonus** for both Senior & Junior Breed Champions. Prize money can be collected on the day of the show from 2.30pm onwards – prize money will be forfeited if not collected on the day.

Judging will start at approximately 8.30am – the order of judging will be provided after the entries close. The Committee reserves the right to remove any animal from a class if not under control. \*\*NOSE SNIPS/HUMBUGS ARE COMPULSORY\*\* PLEASE NOTE: any Breed Champion not forward for the Overall Championships will forfeit their prize money, as well as forfeit their right to show at any future Stars of the Future Calf Shows!

**Straw** will be provided in limited supply

The pairs competition, with a guaranteed prize pot of £500, is open to <u>all</u> animals entered which are exhibitor bred & the same breed – any age, any combination is acceptable. Exhibitors can enter as many pairs as they like. The winners of the continental & native pairs will go head to head for the trophy in memory of Joe Watson. ALL PAIRS WILL BE ALLOCATED A <u>SEPARATE</u> NUMBER WHICH MUST BE WORN FOR JUDGING

**Must be bvd accredited or 'negative' status** - if 'not negative' status each animal must be **individually tested** (please upload bvd documentation on entry form - see 'upload information (if necessary)')

**Must be from TB4 or pre-movement tested –** copy of TB test **must** be attached to passport (if applicable)

Passports must accompany all animals and be handed in at the Secretary's desk asap or at the very latest by 8am on Saturday, this includes passports of any dams attending, failure to do so will result in refused entry

All junior young handlers must be accompanied by an adult (this is to comply with Health & Safety). The age range for this section is now 11 to 21 years and the classes will be split accordingly. This section will be judged on Friday evening 10<sup>th</sup> November at 7pm. There will be a Senior & Junior championship, but if there are sufficient entries the Committee may choose to have an Intermediate section. \*\*The overall winner will be presented with The Royal Smithfield Club's trophy\*\*

**Food -** The mart canteen will be open for meals on Friday evening between 6pm & 9pm, then open for breakfast on Saturday morning from 7am - *Pls note these times may change* 

**Refreshments –** There will be a bar as usual open on Friday evening in the show hall.

## BVD HERD STATUS - Additional form for all cattle

ALL CATTLE EXHIBITORS - please note you must declare your BVD status.

If Accredited, please send a copy of your Accreditation Certificate in with your entries

#### **IMPORTANT**

- a) Any animal coming from a Scottish holding must have a "negative" herd status for BVD or be individually tested negative for the BVD virus.
- b) Any animal from a "not negative herd" cannot move to a show unless it has been individually tested negative for the BVD virus.
- c) Any animal coming from outside Scotland should either be from a BVD Cattle Health Certification Standards (CHeCS) accredited herd or be individually tested negative for the BVD virus.
